Community Reacts as AB 349 Signed by Governor Sisolak:

"AB 349 will reduce bad air quality days for Clark and Washoe Counties, which will help families like mine with children who struggle with respiratory issues," said Cinthia Moore, national lead for EcoMadres, a project of Moms Clean Air Force. "Latino children are 60% more likely to suffer from an asthma attack exacerbated by air pollution. We thank the Assembly and the Senate for passing AB 349 to repair or replace polluting vehicles and help improve our air quality and the health of our families."

"Transportation impacts every aspect of our day-to-day lives, from how we get to work, how we get to the grocery store, visit the doctor, to even the very air that we breathe," said Rev. Jackson with the Faith Organizing Alliance. "Yet not all members of our community have the same access and ease of mobility as others, and we do not bear the burden of air pollution the same way. One of the ways we think we can address this is by reducing pollution that comes from vehicles, to reduce contamination that is making our community sick."--Thank you Governor Sisolak, for your insight and leadership.
